Thank you for your interest in WYDOT's Authorized Travel notification program. The opportunity for you to receive information regarding road closures and authorized travel possibilities via e-mail and/or text messaging is one of WYDOT's most progressive attempts to serve Wyoming travelers. The following is a description of the essential components of the program and an overview of your responsibilities as a partner with WYDOT. Should you wish to participate in this program you must complete the subscription found at the end of this packet and return it to the address listed.

---

Wyoming Statute 24-1-109 allows for WHP/WYDOT personnel to authorize travel on closed roads. The statute imposes specific guidelines upon the individual requesting to travel on a closed road and upon WHP/WYDOT.

Any person traveling upon a closed section of highway must have been authorized to do so by WHP/WYDOT. Individuals traveling on closed sections of highway without WHP/WYDOT authorization are subject to penalty under state statute.

## General Information

After acceptance into the WYDOT Authorized Travel program, participants will begin to receive messages which specifically identify if travel is authorized on their approved roadway segment(s). Please remember that being accepted into the WYDOT Authorized Travel program does not give an individual blanket permission to travel on a closed road. Travel on a closed road is authorized on an event-by-event basis and only applies to those specific roadways as described by the text and/or e-mail notification.

Roadways are classified as:

- A. **OPEN.** In this scenario, no restrictions other than legal restrictions related to size and weight shall apply to travel on the roadway. Advisories, such as strong winds, black ice, no unnecessary travel and reduced visibility may also be in effect.  
or
- B. **CLOSED.** In this scenario, no driver is authorized to travel upon the roadway. Anyone traveling on a closed road is considered to be in violation of the road closed statute and is subject to penalty.  
or
- C. **Closed with WYDOT Authorized Travel.** When a roadway is "Closed with WYDOT Authorized Travel" it means that a specific section of the closed roadway is deemed passable for authorized traffic only. It also means that any person operating a vehicle on

that closed section of roadway must have been authorized to do so in any one of three ways:

1. The driver of the vehicle has been given permission to proceed by a state trooper or WYDOT maintenance employee at the road closed gate. If no trooper or WYDOT maintenance employee is at the gate, travel on the road is prohibited, unless authorized as described in item numbers two and three below.
2. The driver of the vehicle has contacted WHP dispatch at 800-442-9090 or 307-777-4321 and has been given permission to travel on the roadway. A request to travel must be made for each closure event.
3. The driver of the vehicle has been accepted into the WYDOT Authorized Travel program and has received information via text message and/or e-mail that travel is authorized on the section of roadway upon which they intend to travel. ***Information authorizing travel upon a closed road will be specific to the storm or event occurring at the time the information is received and does not extend beyond that specific event. Subsequent text and email messages may alter or reverse previous messages for that specific roadway during a storm or event.*** In such cases the driver should, whenever possible, have a copy of the e-mail notification or a text message on their cell phone advising them of the authorization to travel. If permission is granted to travel, the authorized driver may travel beyond a closure gate whether or not a trooper or WYDOT maintenance employee is at the gate.

## Application Process

Individuals who wish to participate in the WYDOT Authorized Travel program must subscribe annually by completing the subscription form. Once the subscription application is received, reviewed, and approved, the applicant will be subscribed by WYDOT to the appropriate roadway segment(s).

Each individual driver who wishes to receive authorization for local travel on a closed roadway must submit a subscription application. Group or family subscriptions are not allowed. It is necessary for WYDOT to have an individual name and e-mail or cell phone combination in our database to verify the delivery and receipt of notifications. The name in the database must match up with the driver's license of the driver of any vehicle on a closed road. While permission to travel is not vehicle specific, WYDOT will use vehicle descriptions when attempting to locate any vehicle not arriving at a destination on a closed road.

When completing the roadway section of the subscription application, please select all segments for which you wish to be authorized for travel. Information you provide will allow WYDOT to build a notification process unique to your anticipated travel plans. You will receive closure and travel authorization information only on the roadway segments you list and for which you are approved. It is not necessary to provide direction of travel on your selected roadway segments. Restrictions, if any, on direction of travel will be provided in the notification process.

Your application will be reviewed by Wyoming Highway Patrol personnel based on the necessity of your need to travel. Patrol personnel may accept your request to travel on one or more closed segments. Once the review is complete, you will receive a letter at the email address you provided which will inform you of the road segment(s) for which you have been approved to travel in an "Authorized Travel" event. Every effort will be made to review applications quickly; however, unforeseen events may delay this process slightly.

You are NOT authorized to travel on closed roads until your application has been approved and you receive email/text notifications that authorize you to travel. Notifications will be made on a per event basis and authorization to travel on a closed road can be rescinded at any time, should conditions warrant.

Until your application is approved, permission to travel on closed roads may be granted on a per event basis by:

- A state trooper or WYDOT maintenance employee at the road closure gate
- Contacting WHP dispatch at 800-442-9090 or 307-777-4321

WYDOT encourages all winter travelers to be prepared for sudden and dramatic changes in weather condition. Four wheel drive vehicles, all wheel drive vehicles or two wheel drive vehicles with good quality snow tires will help travelers maintain a margin of safety while traveling on winter roads. A winter survival kit to include a method of communication, water, food, blanket, flares, shovel, and extra winter clothing should be carried in your vehicle.
